



Dear Junior Tournament Organiser,

Please find attached the junior calendar form for all junior events in 2010. In 2010 the Jack Newton Junior Golf Foundation is looking to increase their involvement and promotion of all junior club events. The Jack Newton Junior Golf Foundation is looking to do this in a variety of ways.

The Jack Newton Junior Golf Foundation (JNJGF) has historically used some club events as Subaru State Age Qualifying events. In 2010 the JNJGF will be looking to continue this as well as use local club events as junior scoring average events.

Each junior club event will be given the option to become a Subaru State Age Qualifying event and / or a junior scoring average event. A description of both events and what is required by each club to be classified as a qualifying event for the Subaru State Age Championships or to become a junior scoring average event can be found later in this document.

A recent decision was made by the NSW Golf Association and the Jack Newton Junior Golf Foundation to increase the age of a junior in NSW to U/19. It would be appreciated if all clubs could reflect this change in their junior events.

These new changes are designed to both increase the number of participants in all junior club events as well as develop the relationship between the JNJGF and golf clubs around NSW.

It would be greatly appreciated if all clubs could return their junior calendar forms to the JNJGF no later than Friday September 25, 2009. If you have any questions regarding the calendar or your clubs junior event please do not hesitate to contact us.

Subaru State Age Championships

The Subaru State Age Championships is held every year in the second week of the July school holidays. The event is held over four days over two different golf courses. This event is designed to find the best junior golfer in each age group. In 2010 the event will be held at Catalina Country Club and Mollymook Hilltop Golf Course on the South Coast of NSW with approximately 300 players.

To enter the event players must qualify for the event. At this stage qualification is for boys only. Girls may enter the event without qualifying although the JNJGF reserves the right to refuse entry to any girl if they believe the girl is not up to the standard required to compete in this event.

Age qualifying for the 2010 tournaments begins in July 2009 and concludes at the end of June 2010.

ALL JUNIOR EVENTS ARE ELIGIBLE TO BECOME A SUBARU STATE AGE QUALIFYING EVENT.

How to Qualify

All boys who want to attempt to qualify for the Subaru State Age Championships must submit an age registration form and pay the \$20 before January 4, 2010. After this time a late fee of \$20 may apply. All age qualifying scores will be taken into consideration AFTER a player has submitted an age registration form. NO results before the age registration form is received will be taken into consideration. Players who have not submitted an age registration form are permitted to play in age qualifying events however; they are not eligible to qualify for the Subaru State Age Championships.

ONCE A PLAYER HAS COMPLETED AN AGE REGISTRATION FORM there are three ways to qualify for the Subaru State Age Championships.

1. All scratch champions in all age groups of all club and JNJGF age qualifying events.
2. All club junior champions.
3. The final way is via the pool. A player will have their best age qualifying round recorded. This is called their "pool" score. Once all the players in the above two criteria have been accepted into the event the JNJGF will determine how many spots are available in each age group. The players with the best "pool" scores will be accepted into the event. Players may participate in multiple age qualifying events to improve their "pool" score.

Responsibility of club junior tournament organiser

1. Promote to all players that this is an age qualifying event.
2. Collect all age registration forms and return to JNJGF.
3. Return to the JNJGF a full list of results with a players scratch score, current age, PAR of the course and the CCR of the course on the day.

Benefit for a club to become an age qualifying event

1. An increase in participants as many players attempt to qualify for the Subaru State Age Championships.
2. Promotion of the club junior tournament on the JNJGF calendar and JNJGF website.

Junior Scoring Average

In the past there have been three different scoring averages for junior golfers in NSW. These averages were taken from different events in different formats. In 2010 the "junior average" events will be all JNJGF tournaments and a select number of club junior tournaments. This average will be taken on a calendar year basis.

To be eligible for a JNJGF scoring average and to be eligible to win the Junior age scoring average trophy a player must participate in a minimum of twelve (12) junior ranking rounds in a calendar year. Of these rounds a minimum two (2) round must come from a NON JNJGF tournament, i.e. a club junior tournament that is a junior "scoring average" event.

The age scoring average trophy will be awarded to the player with the lowest average in each age group during the calendar year who has met all the necessary criteria.

All club junior tournaments will need to apply to become a junior ranking event. In order to apply a club must meet the following minimum requirements.

- ❖ A minimum of 40 participants in 2009 with a minimum of 10 players off a handicap of 9 or less.
- ❖ Must be an age qualifying event

After all submissions are made the JNJGF in conjunction with the NSWGA and the WGNSW will determine and notify all clubs whether they were successful in gaining junior scoring average status.

NB. If your club is not granted junior ranking status this will not impede on their ability to be a Subaru State Age Qualifying Event. All junior events are eligible to become a Subaru State Age Qualifying event.

Junior Calendar Information

When deciding on a date for your junior event please consult with other clubs within your region. The JNJGF will not promote two tournaments in the same region on the same day. Please see below a list of all JNJGF events in 2010 as well as school holiday dates for NSW public schools.
